Sunday	9 am – 10 pm	9 am – 7 pm


The cable car operates every 15 minutes.

## How to get there

Public transport from Dornbirn with the bus route 46, 47, 8 Bus stop: Karren cable car station


By car: Leave the motorway at exit 18 Dornbirn Süd and continue along L 204 (Lustenauerstrasse in the direction of Dornbirn centre. After 2.2km, continue straight ahead through the junction at Dornbirn Hospital and L 190 and follow the signs to the cable car station.












Wonderful hike and walking routes, breathtaking viewes of the Rhine Valley - and evenings with a glittering sea of light from down below. The Karren is a very popular meeting place in this region. It is the starting point for many beautiful walking tours and is also very relaxing to stay at the top of Karren Mountain at an altitude of 976 meters, whether to have a meal at the Panoramarestaurant or just enjoy the view. In just five minutes the cable car will take you above the roofs of the town, giving you a beautiful view from the overlook/observation point of three countries during the day and night.





## Rappenloch Gorge and Alploch Gorge

The mountains behind Dornbirn offers you two very spectacular jewels of nature, hidden but well known beyond the region - the Rappenloch and the Alploch gorge. For ten thousands of years the water of the Dornbirner Ach river has rushed its way through the limestone turning it into these two wild romantic ravines. Today it is an awe - inspiring sight for the visitors watching the water rushing through the rocks. Exciting footbridges take you through the gorge and past extraordinary rock formations.
